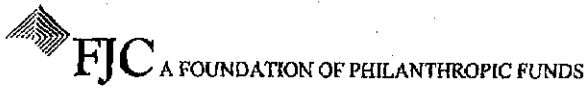



**Friends of Fresh and Green Project Goals January 8, 2010 to January 8, 2011**

1. **Increase student sponsorship to 100%.** Current student sponsorship is 30 students out of a possible 90. Each student sponsor pays \$25 per month (\$300 per year), therefore, at 30 students, FFG currently receives \$750 per month. With 100% sponsorship of 90 students, FFG will receive \$2,250 per month (\$27,000 per year) to go directly to the Academy in Addis Ababa.

Through a six-month Sponsorship Drive, FFG plans to achieve 100% sponsorship (or its equivalent in cash donations) by October 15, 2010.

2. **Utilize Equal Exchange Fair Trade product sales to raise monies for FFG.** Through the sale of Equal Exchange products (chocolate, tea, coffee and nuts) via school and church fundraisers, FFG will raise \$1,000 by January 8, 2010. 3. **Board Member Fundraisers.** Each of the four current board members will host one or more fundraisers in their community to raise a total \$500 or more, (board member may elect to provide the equivalent in a cash donation.)

With four fundraisers, FFG will raise \$2,000 by October 15, 2010. Planned fundraisers, locations and dates are as follows (activities and dates may change):

Cocktail Fundraiser/Silent Auction, New York City, April 8, 2010

Outdoor Concert/Silent Auction, Evanston, Illinois, July 10, 2010

Las Vegas Fundraiser, August, 2010

Poker/Casino night, New York City, September 13, 2010
